

An Open Letter to Prime Minister Bart De Wever

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The Premier of the Kingdom of Belgium and the Iron Architect of the New Fiscal Order

Monsieur le Premier Ministre, Mijnheer De Wever,

I am writing this letter to you from a busy café on the Wetstraat in Brussels, just steps away from your official office at Number 16.
