

A Letter to the President

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To His Excellency Nasry Asfura

President of the Republic of Honduras

Presidential Palace, Tegucigalpa

Mr. President,

Do not let the legacy of your term be defined by the political fractures of the past. Let it be defined by your ability to bring the "Honduran family" together and deliver concrete, lasting progress.

The people of Honduras are resilient, Mr. President. Provide the security, the transparency, and the opportunity we deserve, and you will find that this nation has the strength to achieve the greatness it is capable of.
