

An Open Letter to Prime Minister Robert Fico

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Dear Prime Minister,

I am writing this letter to you from a quiet corner in Bratislava, looking out over the Danube towards the castle. To the outside world, Slovakia is often viewed as a picturesque, industrial heart of Central Europe—famed for its stunning Tatra mountains, its status as a global leader in per-capita car production, and its deep historical roots.

But beneath this quiet, scenic exterior, Slovakia is living through its most tense, polarized, and fragile era in modern history. It has been two years since the horrific assassination attempt against you shocked the world. The Cost-of-Living Squeeze and Stagnation: While your government focuses heavily on political reforms and judicial reshuffling, Slovak households are quietly drowning in everyday economic pressure. Inflation and rising energy costs have hit our pensioners and families hard. Our economy remains dangerously over-reliant on traditional automotive assembly, leaving us highly vulnerable to global market shifts. We don't need short-term, populist social handouts; we need a long-term plan to boost local innovation, raise wages, and modernize our crumbling public infrastructure.

The Brain Drain and Youth Exodus: Slovakia is facing a quiet demographic tragedy. Our brightest young minds, students, and medical professionals are leaving the country in droves, mostly moving to the Czech Republic or Western Europe. They are fleeing not just for better salaries, but because they are suffocated by the toxic domestic atmosphere, the lack of modern opportunities, and the ideological culture wars championed by your coalition partners. If you continue to alienate the youth, you will soon be ruling over a rapidly aging, hollowed-out country.

Dangerous Geopolitical Isolated Stance: Your "sovereign foreign policy"—characterized by cutting off military aid to Ukraine, criticizing Western sanctions, and shifting toward a more Moscow-friendly rhetoric—has placed Slovakia in a precarious position. By closely mimicking the political playbook of Viktor Orbán, you risk alienating our vital European and NATO allies. Focus your immense political power on fixing our healthcare system, rescuing the economy, and proving to the world that Slovakia can be a proud, sovereign nation without sacrificing its democratic soul or its European future.
