

An Open Letter to President Vladimir Putin

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Sir,

I am writing this letter to you from a high-rise suburb in Moscow, far from the gilded, imperial halls of the Grand Kremlin Palace. You have managed the Russian state for over a quarter of a century. Through absolute administrative control, ruthless suppression of the opposition, and total dominance over the media, you have built a monumental security vertical. Your supporters credit you with restoring Russia's status as a global geopolitical pole and building an economy resilient to thousands of Western sanctions. To the outside world, you are a calculated, hardline autocrat who reshaped the map of Europe.

But let us peel back the state-media propaganda and look closely at the reality facing ordinary Russians in June 2026. The mobilization, the staggering human costs of the ongoing conflict, and the massive exodus of over a million of our brightest young professionals, IT engineers, and scientists have drained the country of its future. You are sacrificing Russia's youth on the altar of your personal historical legacy. A nation cannot remain great if its factories lack engineers, its hospitals lack doctors, and its birth rate has collapsed to historic, terrifying lows.

Total Domestic Suppression and the Rule of Fear: Under the pretext of defending "traditional values" and "national security," you have criminalized dissent to an unprecedented degree. Independent journalism has been completely exiled, civil society has been branded as "foreign agents," and ordinary citizens face years in penal colonies for simple social media posts. A truly strong and confident state does not need to jail poets, students, and peaceful protesters to preserve its stability. By crushing all open political discourse, you are creating a fragile, brittle system where any future transition of power will likely turn chaotic and violent.

The Complete Submission to Beijing: While your propaganda apparatus constantly rails against Western hegemony and claims Russia is a fully sovereign superpower, your policies have effectively transformed our economy into a raw-materials appendage of China. You continue to squander the country's human and financial resources in the fires of the bloodiest war unleashed since World War II—a war started by you.
