

An Open Letter to His Majesty King Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck

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The Dragon King of Thimphu and the Chief Architect of Gross National Happiness

Addressing Human Rights and International Image Legacies: As Bhutan positions itself as an enlightened, modern democracy to attract foreign investment, your administration faces renewed international scrutiny regarding unresolved legacy issues. Moving into 2026, international bodies continue to push for the resolution of long-standing cases concerning political prisoners from the Lhotshampa (Nepali-speaking) community, testing the state's judicial system to align traditional royal mercy (kidu) with global human rights standards.

Your Majesty, you have masterfully proved that a small Himalayan nation can command deep global respect by prioritizing ecological balance and societal well-

being over raw industrial output.

The turning point of 2026 requires converting Bhutan's massive environmental and moral authority into concrete economic opportunities for its youth. By making the Gelephu Mindfulness City an undeniable success, lowering entry barriers for foreign direct investment, and digitizing the domestic economy, you will ensure that the Kingdom of the Thunder Dragon remains both culturally untainted and economically self-reliant for generations to come.
