

Open Letter to Prime Minister Nawaf Salam

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His Excellency Nawaf Salam Prime Minister of the Lebanese Republic Grand Serail,
Beirut, Lebanon

Your Excellency,

As Prime Minister, serving alongside President Joseph Aoun, you represent the highest executive authority of the Lebanese Republic in 2026. This administration—a partnership between the President and the Prime Minister—carries the ultimate responsibility for halting the disintegration of the state. The current moment is not one for conventional governance; it is a moment for the radical reclamation of Lebanese sovereignty.

Your executive mandate for the remainder of 2026 requires a decisive shift in state policy:

Unified State Command: Under the joint leadership of President Aoun and yourself, the executive branch must assert its monopoly on state decision-making. The Cabinet

must function as a cohesive organ of the Republic, not a reflection of sectarian division. You have a mandate to restore order and discipline across all ministries, ensuring that state policies are implemented without obstruction from non-state actors or factional interests.

Structural Economic Salvation: The window for fiscal recovery is closing. You must immediately accelerate the implementation of the long-delayed structural reform program agreed upon with international partners and the IMF. This requires a total overhaul of the central bank's operational transparency and a decisive resolution to the banking crisis. The state must provide a clear roadmap for the restoration of public savings and the stabilization of the currency.

Sovereign Neutrality: To secure Lebanon's future, your administration must enforce a policy of strict national sovereignty. Diplomacy must be oriented solely toward the stabilization of the Lebanese economy and the protection of its borders. By distancing the state from regional proxy alignments, you will create the necessary diplomatic space to attract the international investment required for reconstruction.

Institutional Meritocracy: You have the task of transitioning the civil service toward professional meritocracy. Replacing sectarian patronage with competency-based administration is the only way to restore the basic public services—electricity, infrastructure, and healthcare—that the Lebanese people demand. This is not merely an administrative shift; it is a prerequisite for national survival.

Mr. Prime Minister, the Lebanese state is at a crossroads. History will judge this administration by whether it succeeded in re-establishing the dignity and functionality of the Republic. You are the architect of the state's recovery; the time for decisive, singular action is now.
